Thoughts on Miss Valerie Horniman, Headmistress at SCEGGS Moss Vale from 1968 to 1972

Miss Horniman died on 27th May 2016 and there was a memorial service for her on 10th June 2016.

As the Headmistress of a Girls' Boarding school, Miss Horniman appeared to many of us as a reserved, neatly dressed, rather strict, Christian and somewhat enigmatic woman. We were to gradually discover that one could glimpse an intelligent person, possessed of fairness, insight, who loved a joke and seeing others have fun and succeed. She did her best to help students achieve their goals in and we express our gratitude for the benefits that still flow from her encouragement. Her interest in and support of music and the arts steered school life in her time there.

Many years later, perhaps thirty-five years later, when she attended an "Old Girls" dinner in Sydney, we were able to hear her stories and adventures while teaching in China. It dawned on us how young she must have been when she was Headmistress. What responsibilities she had taken on as such a young woman! And we wondered if she had actually been a little frightened by what she faced.

A vivid memory, many senior students have, is being invited at short notice one cold morning into the Headmistress' flat, to sit around on the carpet in the living-room warmth, in front of her small black-and-white TV. What a rare privilege to witness man's "giant leap" the first landing on the moon, in grainy images, on that little TV. One student relived the living-room scene recently in mid-May, watching a time-worn Buzz Aldrin sign copies of his new memoir at the Smithsonian National Air and Space Museum, Washington, DC, USA. It was titled: "No dream is Too High".

This description, "no dream is too high", seems apt for Valerie Horniman, too, in how she taught and lived.
